

# C5 FORUM HAWAII (CFH) LOCATION – BOTH DAYS

Hale Ikena Community Center – Fort Shafter Building 711 Morton Drive Honolulu, HI 96853

The event will be held in the Pikake Ballroom and lanai area at the Hale Ikena. The Hale Ikena is located at the Fort Shafter Golf Course.

**PLEASE NOTE:** You DO NOT need to bring your event ticket. We will have the attendee roster at the Registration Table.

## **EVENT DAYS AND TIMES**

- C5 Event Days & Hours: Wednesday, April 16<sup>th</sup> | 9:30 a.m. 3:30 p.m. & Thursday, April 17<sup>th</sup> | 9:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m.
- Registration: Registration will remain open throughout the day (on both days) if you cannot make the official registration time.

## **SECURITY & ACCESS**

- Individuals with a Common Access Card (CAC), Government ID, Retired Military ID, or Fort Shafter DBIDS (other installations not accepted) can show their badge and will be granted access to Fort Shafter.
- If you submit your PII security information to us by <u>Friday, March 28, 2025.</u>, our Event Access List will be at the Fort Shafter Main Gate (Buckner Gate), and you can drive on without having to go to the Tripler Pass & ID Office to get a pass. You will just need to show your Real ID Driver's License and let the gate guard know that you are on the "Event Access List for the C5 Forum at the Hale Ikena (Club at the Golf Course)".
- If you chose not to/or did not submit your security information to us, you can still get a Visitors Pass but be advised that the Fort Shafter Pass and ID Visitors Center at the Buckner (Main Gate) is now closed. You will need to go to go to Tripler's Pass and ID Office to get a Visitors Pass. The pass will be good for 6 days. The Pass & ID Office is open 24/7. The process to get a Visitors Pass at the Tripler Pass & ID Office can take 20-minutes or longer. To avoid lines and delays get your pass as early in the morning as possible.
- Directions to the Tripler Medical Center Pass & ID Office:

- o Take H-1 West towards Waianae.
- o Follow signs and take a slight left at H-201 West towards Aiea.
- Follow signs for Tripler Army Medical Center (Exit sign says Puuloa Rd./Tripler Hosp.)
- o You will go up the hill and be directed to the Visitors Center on the right-hand side.

## **DIRECTIONS**

### FROM WAIKIKI:

- Take the H1 West from Waikiki.
- On H1-West keep left at the fork to merge onto I-H-201 W, follow signs for Interstate H201 W/Aiea/Fort Shafter.
- Take the Exit 4 Fort Shafter onto Kikowaena Road.
- Turn right through the Main Gate (Buckner Gate) onto Funston Road.
- You will be funneled down the hill to the Gate Guard.
- Then you will go back up the hill and make a right at the stop sign back onto Funston Road.
- From Funston Road you will make a left on Carter Drive from left turn only lane.
- Follow Carter Drive and take sharp right up hill onto Morton Drive
- The entrance to Hale Ikena is on left.

# **PARKING & PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

Parking is available in front of the Hale Ikena, and on both sides.

Public transportation such as Ubers, or Taxis, will not be allowed to access Fort Shafter.

### **DRESS CODE & MASKS**

The dress code for C5 Forum is Aloha Wear (Aloha shirt and khakis), business casual, or uniform of the day. Masks now optional at all DoD facilities. Bring a mask if you choose to wear one.
